Question: 10

Explanation:

The agile team members are required to be dedicated and focused on the project they are working. When the team member is not fully dedicated on the project the project suffers. And when the team member switches between two projects, his attention and capacity divides between the projects, and 20-40% of the productivity loses. The ideal solution to this problem is that the current manager should discuss with the former manager to resolve the issue. But this case is not available in the option.

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
